**CODE OF CONDUCT / ASSUMPTION OF RISK**

The Levittown Swimming Association (LSA) enforces a Code of Conduct for all LSA sponsored events and practices. This code regards the treatment of swimmers and other children. The Code is inflexible and strictly enforced. Parents, Coaches or Swimmers may be banned from attendance for any violation to the Code of Conduct.

1. The physical or verbal abuse of any swimmer by a Coach, Parent or any other person connected to the organization is specifically forbidden. Physical abuse is defined as including (but not limited to) hitting, slapping, kicking, jerking, shaking or any other physical contact with the swimmer designed to discipline or humiliate. Verbal abuse is defined as any screaming or terminology directed at a swimmer with the intent of humiliation or demeaning the swimmer.
2. Profanity, obscenities, smoking, drinking of alcoholic beverages or consumption of illegal drugs is strictly prohibited around the swimmers (meets and practices).
3. Any display of poor sportsmanship, such as aggressive or profane abuse directed at Swim Officials, Meet Directors, Volunteers or any other person, from the sidelines is also forbidden. Only the Head Coach (or acting Head Coach) is allowed to speak to officials. Parents and Assistant Coaches are forbidden from speaking to or criticizing the officials. Booning is not allowed under any circumstances.
4. Regarding the competitive nature of the swim meets; it is the obligation of Parents and Coaches to model correct sportsmanship to the swimmers regardless of the outcome. Coaches, Parents and Swimmers should be gracious in both victory and defeat. Taunting will not be tolerated. Parents and Coaches should emphasize and reward effort above winning and losing. Compliments should be freely given regardless of outcome.

The Code of Conduct is not written with the intent to limit or restrict a Parent's or Coach's desire or ability to teach and lead the youth he/she is working with. It is directed to enable us all to present a public posture that is above reproach and outside criticism. Above all, it is designed to create a positive and safe environment for developing the skills and character of our youth.

I have read the Code of Conduct, acknowledge that all participants are subject to it, and agree to do my part to ensure my child(ren) and I abide by it.

I further agree and understand that this program involves being in and around swimming pools. I am aware that any contact with a swimming pool involves certain risks, including but not limited to: death, drowning, or other personal injury as a result of the area's conditions; the acts of third parties or other unknown safety hazards; diving injury; skin, eye, lung and ear irritation; injuries resulting from loss of balance and footing on aquatic surfaces; injuries resulting from lack of oxygen; injuries due to conditions of equipment; unpredictability of weather and the water conditions; first aid operations or procedures of LSA and/or others; and that there may be other risks not known to me and/or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.

I KNOWINGLY AND VOLUNTARILY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, BOTH KNOWN AND UNKNOWN, INCLUDING THOSE ARISING FROM THE ACTS OF LSA, UNLESS THOSE RISKS ARISE DIRECTLY FROM LSA'S GROSS NEGLIGENCE OR INTENTIONAL MISCONDUCT, and I AGREE TO HOLD LSA HARMLESS and ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY for the health and safety of my guests, my child/children and myself while participating in the LSA program and during their time using the swimming and recreational facilities.
